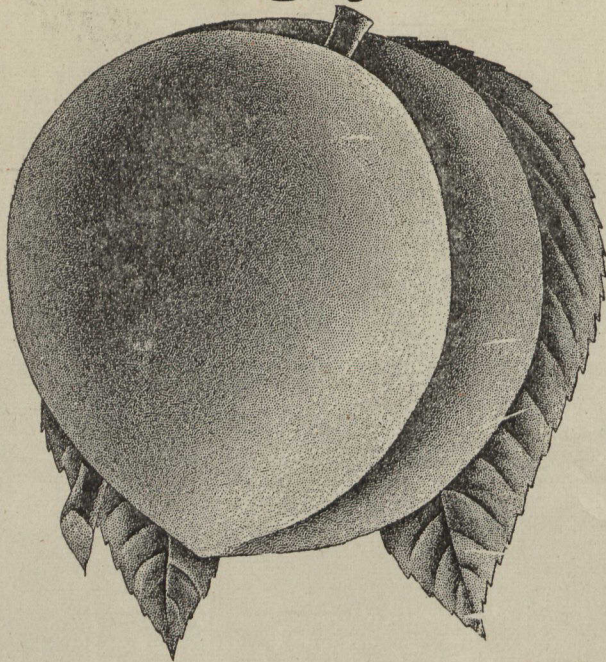


The big problem of the "little peach"
