Morning Post states that the French mathematicians, MM. Charles and Leverrier, have accepted nomination as members of the Academy of Sciences at Berlin. They are the first Frenchmen who have accepted the distinction since the war. The same correspondent says that Dr. Dollinger is engagaged in editing for publication the hitherto unpublished portions of the reports of the Council of Trent. -The Academy reports that the eminent Swedish palæontologist, Professor Nils Peter Angelin, died at Stockholm on the 13th February, in The untiring his seventy-first year. pursuit of palæontology, of which science he was the first and remained the greatest master in the North, wasted his resources year by year, and if he had not found elsewhere, notably in Denmark and Germany, the encouragement Sweden refused him, he must often have ceased his exertions.

—A memorial to the Senate of London University, asking that degrees in music may be rendered available by that body upon a basis of sound general culture, has been presented by the Council of Trinity College, London, supported by the signatures of Sir Julius Benedict, Sir Michael Cost., Sir John Goss, Sir George J.
