

Fabrics in which the nylon fibre accounts for 50 per cent or more by weight or thread count or where the nylon fibres in combination with other fibres represent the chief value. (Poland, Taiwan, Thailand)

Household Textiles

Bedsheets, woven, including flannelette sheets.

Pillowcases, woven.

Tablecloths, both finished or partially manufactured, woven or knit, of polyester and/or polyester/cotton fabrics (as defined above), up to and including 406 cm. in length. This includes tablecloths which have been cut to size and hemmed, fused, fringed or marrowed and are intended to cover a table, chest, sideboard or similar article. Included are tablecloths which are part of sets comprised of matching or coordinated table mats or runners, tea napkins, drip mats and/or serviettes.

Cotton Terry Towels, Washcloths and Sets containing 50 per cent or more by weight of cotton. Cotton terry towels, washcloths and sets are of fabrics woven on a terry loom using single or plied cotton (or blends thereof) yarns with loop pile on one or both sides covering the entire surface on either plain or patterned weave, whether greige, bleached, dyed or printed, including tea, hand, beach and bath towels and bath sheets, barmops and towel blanks.

Hosiery, is knitted footwear for adults, children and infants. Excluded are ladies' seamless or full-fashioned full-length hosiery and knee highs produced on machines of 400 needles or above and made from yarn of 30 denier or finer, and panty-hose. (P.R. China, South Korea, Taiwan)

Knitted footwear for adults, children and infants. Excluded are men's and boys' woolen hosiery (over 50 per cent of wool by weight) and ladies' seamless or full fashioned full length hosiery and knee highs produced on machines of 400 needles or above and made from yarn of 30 denier or finer, and panty-hose. (Singapore, Thailand)
