SIR,

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your Note No. FLA-126 of February 27, 1976, together with its Annex, in which you propose a number of amendments to the Agreement between the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany and the Government of Canada concerning the training of Bundeswehr units in Canada at Canadian Forces Base Shilo, constituted by an Exchange of Notes done at Ottawa on January 23, 1974.

The German version of your Note reads as follows:
