

On motion of Mr. Zaplitny, seconded by Mr. Johnson (Kindersley), it was ordered,—That an humble Address be presented to His Excellency the Governor General praying that he will cause to be laid before this House a copy of all correspondence, telegrams, memoranda and/or any other communications exchanged between the Federal Government or any department thereof, and the Government of Manitoba or any of its departments, since January 1, 1956, with respect to port facilities and grain terminals at the Lakehead. (\*Notice of Motion No. 11).

The Bill No. 16 (Letter S of the Senate), intituled: "An Act respecting Canadian Pacific Railway Company and certain wholly owned subsidiaries" was again considered in Committee of the Whole, reported without amendment, read the third time and passed.

The House resumed the adjourned debate on the proposed motion of Mr. Fairey, seconded by Mr. Byrne,—That Bill No. 15 (Letter I of the Senate), intituled: "An Act respecting Trans Mountain Oil Pipe Line Company", be now read the second time.

And on the proposed motion of Mr. Cameron (Nanaimo), seconded by Mr. Winch, in amendment thereto:

That Bill No. 15 be not now read a second time, but that the subject matter thereof be referred to the Standing Committee on Railways, Canals and Telegraph Lines.

After further debate; the question being put on the said proposed amendment, it was negatived on the following division:
