Mr. Macdonald (Rosedale), seconded by Mr. Jamieson, proposed to move,—

That upon the adoption of this motion, and continuing in effect until Friday, June 26, 1970, the ordinary hours of sitting and daily adjournment shall be as follows:

Mondays	from 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. from 2.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m. and from 8.00 p.m. to 11.00 p.m.
Tuesdays and Thursdays	from 2.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m. and from 8.00 p.m. to 11.00 p.m.
Wednesdays	from 2.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m. and from 8.00 p.m. to 10.00 p.m.
Fridays	from 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. and from 2.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.

That on Mondays, Government Orders shall be the first order of business taken up at 11.00 a.m. and that the daily Routine Proceedings be called at 2.00 p.m. on Mondays.

That the hour ordinarily provided for Private Members' Business on Friday shall be devoted to Government Business.

That proceedings on an adjournment motion, if any, on Mondays, Tuesdays or Thursdays under Standing Order 40(1) shall be deferred until 11.00 p.m.

That when it is provided in any Standing Order that the business under consideration shall be forthwith disposed of or concluded in any sitting, the hour of daily adjournment for that purpose shall be as stated in part one of this order.
