20. Section eighty-eight of the said Act is repealed and

the following substituted therefor:

Organization and maintenance of employment service.

"88. (1) The Commission shall organize and maintain an employment service for Canada and in respect of the administration of that service shall be responsible to the Minister.

Duty of Commission to collect information.

(2) It shall be the duty of the Commission in organizing and maintaining such employment service, to collect information concerning employment for workers and workers seeking employment and, to the extent the Commission 10 considers it necessary, to make such information available at the employment offices, with a view to assisting workers to obtain employment for which they are fitted and assisting employers to obtain workers most suitable to their needs.

Duties of employment service.

(3) The employment service shall in relation to unemployment insurance, perform such duties under this Act as may be prescribed by the Commission, and undertake such other services in the interests of workers and employers as the Commission in the exercise of its powers may 20 prescribe.

Additional duties of the Commission.

(4) The Commission shall assume and carry out such other duties and responsibilities as the Governor in Council. on the recommendation of the Minister, may require from time to time and, in respect of such other duties and 25 responsibilities, shall be responsible to the Minister."
