

ARTICLE VI.

Any member who shall be in arrears for dues for more than six (6) months, shall be ineligible to office, and shall not be entitled to vote at any meeting, or to enjoy the privileges of this Society in any manner. But when the Board of Directors shall be satisfied that any worthy member of this Society is unable, for the time being, to pay the dues hereinbefore prescribed, it shall have power to remit such dues.

ARTICLE VII.

The President shall have power to grant leave of absence to any officer of the Society for a period not exceeding two (2) months, and to appoint some suitable person to perform the duties of such officer during his absence, provided that any officer desiring leave of absence shall give the President one week's notice thereof.

ARTICLE VIII.

Whenever it shall be notified to the Board of Directors that any officer of the Society is absent, and has been absent for a longer period than three (3) months, the Board may thereupon declare the office vacant, and appoint some other person to fill the vacancy.
