In Mr. Mears's Memorial of the 30th April 1790. (N° 5.)

July 2d 1789, in Friendly Cove, Nootka Sound.

RECEIVED from Robert Funter, Two hundred and Three Sea Otter Skins, numbered 1 to 215, in good Order and well-conditioned, of which Numbers Twelve are wanting, viz. N° 96, 170, 179, 180, 163, 197, 199, 202, 203, 205, 208, and 204, which I promise to deliver in the like good Order and Condition at Macao, Canton, or any other Port where they may be ordered by the Established Company of Merchants trading from the above Ports to this Coast.
