Permit me here to observe, that, when Military Officers are laid afide, they are reduced to Half-Pay only, even though they have perhaps hazarded their Lives in their Country's Service. What Pretence, then, these Gentlemen could have had to more than their Salaries, I. must own that I am at a Loss to conceive. Other Places, altogether as useless, remain untouched; and, instead of making fuch Savings of the public Treasure, as eafily might have been made, we feem to have been more profulely lavish of it, in proportion as we can less afford it. What, shameful and confused Accounts of Mon, neys expended in Germany, some of it too without proper Vouchers, have we not known pass a certain Place almost. without a fingle Question being asked, under the baneful Influence of this Gentleman's
