BEACON HILL PARK

This magnificent park of about 300 acres is situated on the Straits of Fuca, within a few minutes walk of the business portion of the city. It commands grand panoramic views of the snow-capped Olympics, Mount Baker, Race Rock Lighthouse,

the San Juan Islands, Clover Point (where Captain Vancouver landed in 1792), the Sooke Mountains, etc. This park contains zoological gardens, large recreation grounds, splendid old "oaks," pretty flowering shrubs, grassy stretches and meadows, shady walks, and beautiful lakes inhabited by gold fish, and by stately swans and other water fowls.
