

APPENDIX.

REPORT OF THE SUB-COMMITTEE UPON ENDOWMENT OF PARISHES.

THE Sub Committee upon the Endowment of Parishes beg leave to submit the following Report to the Executive Committee.

The total amount received for this object during 1856, was £649 6 11. Of this sum £141 11 8 is the amount of fourths of contributions from the Parishes, reserved for their own endowment in accordance with the 9th Rule of the Society. Interest on funded money £49 15 3. Donation from Dr. Almon £5, and £453 held in trust, being special donations and the proceeds of Glebe lands sold.

In May 1856, the Committee returned to the Parish of Liverpool the amount of their reserved fourths £64 3 2, and made a grant of £15 16 10 from the general Endowment fund. The whole sum £80 has been invested for the benefit of the incumbent, on Bond and Mortgage in the town of Liverpool.

A grant from the general fund of £5 4 0, has also been made to Lunenburg, and it together with the reserved fourth belonging to that Parish, in all £35, has been invested there for the benefit of the incumbent.

Of the money under the charge of this Committee, £1125 has been invested on Bond and Mortgage at five and a half per cent interest, which has enabled the Committee to increase the rate of interest on all money held in trust for Endowment.

The donation from J. W. Almon, Esq. M. D., being intended as a prize for that Parish which should during 1856 raise the largest amount for its own Endowment, has been transferred to the credit of Antigonishe, the Committee having been satisfied that that Parish was justly entitled to the prize.

Memorandum of Money in the hands of the Endowment Committee at the end of 1856, which accumulates at the rate of 4 per cent. per annum.
