## Reorganization Of Garrison Unit

Present Staff to be Replaced by  
Officers More Recently Returned—Other Changes

The reconstruction of the local No. 7 Canadian Garrison Regiment, according to report, is being proceeded with most satisfactorily and, it is understood, is nearing completion. The garrison regiment has been reduced from a battalion to a detachment and necessarily with demobilization already underway many of the officers who have served with this unit, following service overseas, and who now wish to get back to private life will be given this opportunity to do so. The new personnel of the regiment is said to be as follows:

Major G. E. Barnes, M. C., Captain William Pitt, D. C. M., Captain R. J. Smith, M. C., Lieutenant P. J. Veniot, Lieutenant J. C. Reade, Lieutenant J. K. Halder, D. C. M., and Lieutenant R. H. Dean.

The present staff of officers will, it is reported, retire by the last of February and the new detail of officers will take over their duties and "carry on."

The strength of the detachment after March 1 will be about 313 men; this will be the total strength and will include the mobile and district companies.

The present staff which has carried along the work of the garrison regiment of this district will with the usual procedure of demobilization revert to civil life. They include Lieutenant-Colonel Wedderburn, Major C. J. Morgan, Captain March, Lieutenants Palmer, Cunningham and Patchell. These officers and others of the old staff have done effective work during their tenure of office and have rendered good service to the district.
