Receivers also punishable on failing to give a satisfactory account of now they came by the things stolen. Stealing fruit or vegetables out of gardens is also made pun-

ishable in like manner. By the 7 and 8 Geo. 4, cap. 30 sec. 24, persons wilfully and malicously committing any damage, injnry, or spoil to or upon any real or personal property not specifically provided against, may be summarily convicted before a Justice of the Peace and fined a sum not exceeding £5, by way of compensation. This provision relates to what may be commonly understood by Petty Trespasses.

The last point to which I shall now draw your attention is the remedy provided for Common Assaults by summary conviction, which is a great improvement a Police regulation.
