

Any even numbered section of Domision Lands in Manitoba, Saskatchawan and Alberta, excepting 5 and 5, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 15 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section of 160 acres, more or less.

Batry, numt be made personally, at which the land is situate.

The homesteader is required to perform the conditions connected tharwith under one of the following plans:

(i) At least six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land is estimate.

(ii) If the father (or mothers resides upon a farm in the vicinity of the homestead resides upon a farm in the vicinity of the land entered for, the requirements as to residence may be satisfied by such person residing with the father or mother.

(ii) If the settler has his permanent residence upon farming land owned by him in the vicinity of the homestead, the requirements as to residence may be satisfied by such person residing with the father of mother.
