less, drawn by two horses or other beasts of draught. Two Shillings and Six Pence, and if drawn by one horse or other beasts of draught Two Shillings. For every cart, sled, or other such carriage, loaded or unloaded, drawn by two horses, oxen, or other beasts of draught, with the drivers One Shilling and Six Pence, and if drawn by one horse or other beast of draught One Shilling, For every person on foot Three Pence, For every horse, mare, gelding, mule, or other beast of draught, laden or unladen Six Pence, For a horse and his rider One Shilling, For every bull, ox, cow, and all other horned and neat cattle each Nine Pence, For every hog, goat, sheep, calf or lamb each Three Pence.

IV. And whereas the building and erecting of a Bridge over the river Richelieu will be a work of great magnitude and expence and the Road from Pike River to the faid River Richelieu will necessarily be made and compleated long before such Bridge can be built and erected, Be it therefore further enacted by the authority aforesaid that so soon as the Road from Pike River to the River Richelieu aforesaid shall have been laid out and compleated and duly reported upon and certified and public Notice thereof given in the manner herein before directed and prescribed it shall
