Sat for present seat in L.A., Can., from g. e. 1857 to g. e. 1861, when he was defeated. Returned to present house at last g. e.—*Cedars, Q.*

Ed. at Nicolet College and Wilbraham Academy, Ct., U.S. Graduated as B. C. L. at McGill College. M., 1852, Marguerite, dau. of M. Louis Dupuis, of Three Rivers. Called to the Bar, L. C., 1850. Is a Trustee of the College of Three Rivers, and a mem. of the Town Corporation. First returned to Parlt. at last g. e. for present seat.—*Three Rivers, Q.*
