CAP. I.

An Act for confirming the past Proceedings of His Majesty's Governor and Council, antecedent to the calling of a General Assembly.

TATHEREAS it has been found absolutely necessary and expedient, by His Majesty's Governor and Council of this Island, to make several Resolutions, Rules, Ordinances, and Regulations, for the good government of said Island:

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly, That all the Resolutions, Rules, Ordinances and nor and Council Regulations made by His Majesty's Governor and Council, antecedent to calling a Geneantecedent to the calling of a General Assembly within this ral Assembly.
