

## Jacqueline Mallet, wherever are you?

New York, N.Y. (ENS) - Harper and Row publishers released a new mystery novel this month under circumstances even more mysterious than the plot of the novel.

The book, called "They

Can't Hang Me," was first published in a small edition in England in 1947, written by Jacqueline Mallet. A friend of a Harper and Row editor found the book in a second-hand store in London recently, read it, and sent it on to the publishers who

decided they should re-publish it. And that's when the mystery began.

After searching all over Europe and the U.S., no trace could be found of author Jacqueline Mallet. The book was the only one ever published in England under the author's name, and British critics and literary historians say the name isn't a pen-name for anyone else, and nobody's ever heard of

Jacqueline Mallet.

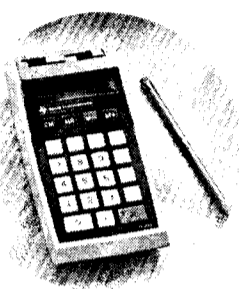
The only possible clue came from a mention of a Jacques Mallet in a *New York Times* newspaper story in 1909. It noted that a Jacques Mallet had arrived in New York from France, after his family had exiled him in an effort to break up a romance with his mistress, who was a young actress. As it happens, the heroine of the book is also a young actress.

So, speculate the publishers, maybe Jacqueline Mallet is a pseudonym for the young mistress, or perhaps she's an illegitimate daughter of Jacques Mallet and his mistress. In any case, Harper and Row says that all proceeds from the book will be held in escrow, "just in case a little old lady should turn up someday and turn out to be Jacqueline Mallet."

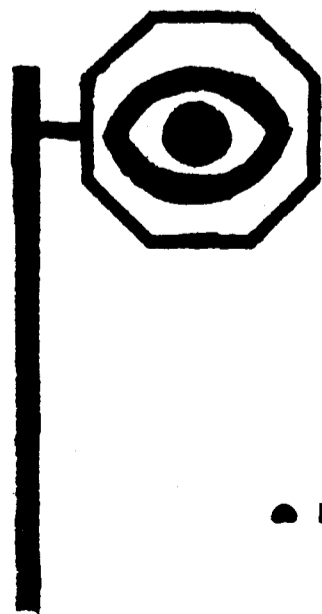
