Mr. J. A. Johnston, signed a Class 2A contract in 1931, but is now being billed as a Class 1B consumer in view of there being four or more contracts which can be served as a group. As stated he has not wired his property for service and in addition there are three other contracts of the same date where service has not been taken on the line to Rideau Ferry.

The majority of the contracts taken are for summer cottage services. A certain number of additional contracts have been received since the line was put in service and these have been applied to reduce guarantee contracts which were taken at the time the line was put in service.

At the present time the number of contracts including those which have not taken service are sufficient to make up standard density. There has been considerable deficit in the operation of this district each year, since the line was put in service.
