Treaty Payments, Oxford House, God's  
Lake and Island Lake, 1939.

1. As requested by your letter of the 14th instant, I am instructing the Officer Commanding at Winnipeg to assign a member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police to accompany the Indian Agent at Norway House on his trip, by plane, to pay treaty at the above mentioned places, leaving Norway House on July 24th, 1939.
