

OTTAWA 1st December 1902-

Sir-

In reply to your letter of the 25th Ultimo submitting a Resolution passed by the Indians of the Restigouche Band, asking for permission to cut and sell some sawlogs and Railway Ties to be taken from the Reserve, I have to inform you that Permits may be issued to members of the Band to cut on defined areas such limited quantities of either as you approve, subject to the payment of double dues at Tariff rates under sworn Returns.

The Resolution should have ~~been~~ specified the probable quantities that the Indians want to make.
