



Sir:-

I am in receipt of your letter of the 7th instant, with which you forwarded an account for \$4.90 in your favour for expenses incurred in connection with locking after the effects of the late William Riley; and in reply I beg to draw your attention to the fact that on the 28th May (file 254006-40) you forwarded to the Department an account of \$6.49 for expenses in the same matter.
