Gentlemen,-

With reference to your letter of the 20th May, No. 50983, re Pte. Frederick Kennedy, No. 1021293, 14th Battalion, (formerly 233rd) I beg to advise you that I have today received some information with regard to this family from our Indian Agent at Duck Lake.

This family is living in the northern part of Saskatchewan, at or near Beauval Post Office, and the Agent suggests that you communicate with the Rev. Father Pinard, C.M.I., who is now Postmaster at Beauval, and who will be able to give you what information you desire with regard to the Kennedys.

In the meantime I have myself written to Father Pinard, and if this family turn out to be Indians I shall advise you later what procedure it has been found advisable to take.
