- 6. Why did the government not resign and allow a conscriptionist government to be formed:
 - 1. because we were committed to conscription if necessary and were not entitled to evade our responsibility;
 - 2. because we could not see the possibility of an alternative government being formed without an election;
 - 3. and because the problem was immediate and could not wait for solution while an election was being held.
- 7. Why was the government so reluctant to resort to conscription, even to a limited extent, until every possible alternative had been exhausted.
