in Brussels on the 27 November 44 did steal money in the amount of approximately 400 Belgian Francs, a cigarette case a cigar case, a razor and blades, a pair of gloves, a watch, a handkerchief, a comb and a tube of toothpaste, the property of Mr. Edward Simon, and a compact and nail file, the property of Mme Gustavie Simon, both of 294 rue Edgar Degas, Brussels.
