I might mention that before the subject of contracting to remove the timber was brought up Mr. Riddell offered to purchase the timber but would not offer above \$2.50 per thousand and whereas if logged off by contract the amount of \$4.00 per thousand FBM would go to the Band Fund instead of the price of \$2.50 if a sale was made.
