1. A superficial inspection was carried out on the subject aircraft at Edmonton Airport on March 14, 1950. The aircraft was found outside, behind the Associated Airways Hangar, partially covered by snow.

2. The fuselage was found in a badly corroded state due to storage in the open with no protection, and is considered beyond economical repair. The main planes were stacked against the rear hangar wall in three feet of snow and can not now be considered repairable. It would therefore, appear that the aircraft is a complete write-off.
