- (a.) Twenty minutes to the essayist.
- (b.) Fifteen minutes to the reader.
- (c.) Ten minutes to each speaker.
- (d.) Five minutes to the leaders for their replies at close of debate.
- (e.) At open meetings fifteen minutes shall be allowed to each speaker and five to the leaders at the close.
- IV. Every motion except a motion to adjourn and every notice of a motion before being offered to the Society shall be put in writing by the mover.
- V. Any by-law may be suspended for one meeting by a majority of the members present at that meeting.
