Ondered, That Mr. McCord, Mr. Viger, Mr. Dumont, Mr. Cockburn, and Mr. Allsopp, do compose the said Committee.

On motion of Mr. A. Stuart, seconded by Mr. Gugy,

RESOLVED, That this House will, on Friday next, the twenty-eighth instant, resolve itself into a Committee of the whole House, to take into consideration whether any, and what amendments, are necessary to the Provincial Act of the forty-first year of His Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act for the establishment of Free Schools, and the advancement of Learning in this Province," and to appropriate funds for the payment of Salaries to Schoolmasters.

An engrossed Bill, to regulate the Militia of the Province of Low-er-Canada, was read for the third time.

Mr. Taschereau, seconded by Mr. M'Cord, moved to resolve, that the Bill do pass, and that the Title be, "An Act to regulate the Militia of the Province of Lower-Canada."

The House divided upon the question:

Yeas 22 Nays 2

So it was carried in the affirmative, and Resolved, accordingly.

ORDERED, That Mr. Taschereau do carry the Bill to the Legislative Council, and desire their concurrence.

An engrossed Bill, for the relief of certain Parishes in distress, was read for the third time.

Mr. Taschereau, seconded by Mr. Panet, moved to resolve, that the Bill do pass, and that the Title be, "An Act for the relief of certain Parishes in distress."

The
