The sum of Sixteen Thousand One Hundred and Postal Service. Forty-three Dollars to be appropriated and expended to defray the expenses of the Postal Service of this Colony; to be expended under and by virtue of the provisions of the Act passed in the Twenty-eighth Year of Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act to Regulate the Inland Posts of this Colony:" Provided always that out of the said sum there shall be expended the sum of Ninety-three Dollars towards defraying the expenses of carrying Newspapers and Printed Papers to and from this Colony; subject to certain rules and regulations made or to be adopted in relation thereto by the Governor in Council.

Proviso,

The sum of Sixty-nine Dollars and Twenty-three Town Clock. Cents towards defraying the expenses of repairing the Town Clock.

The sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars Geological Survey. towards defraying the expenses attending a Geological Survey of this Island.

The sum of Ninety-three Dollars towards defraying Weights and the salary of the Inspector of Weights and Mea-Measures. sures.

The sum of Four Thousand Dollars towards the Bank and Macencouragement of the Bank and Mackerel Fisheries. kerel Fisheries.

The sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars Rifle Shed. for the St. John's Rifle Shed.

The sum of One Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars Cleaning St. John's Streets. for cleaning St. John's Streets.

The sum of One Hundred and Sixteen Dollars for Newfoundland Almanac, the Newfoundland Almanac.

The sum of Five Hundred and Twelve Dollars to- Night Police. wards remunerating the Night Police of St. John's for two months.

The sum of Six Thousand Dollars for the purpose Census Act. of carrying into effect the Census Act: Provided that
