AS TO BRANTFORD'S PUBLIC BUILDING

"Every thinking man in this county knows that it was Lloyd Harris who made the practical move in the direction of a new public building, and so the first appropriation; that Cocksutt is but carrying on work so well begun, and that he has not asked for anything but the best square for nothing, but an exchange of one-half the square for the present post office's position.

"We'll accept your amendment the offer of the old post office building for half the square, but in the rest of it.

"As a matter of fact, the term 'thing' is even then quite appropriate because:

1.—The market square cannot be used for other than market purposes according to the deed of gift.
2.—Said square appears in the assessment rolls as worth \$233.30 the post office \$34,100, so the Laurierite offer was not only a matter of acceptance, but also a matter of fact.

How in the name of Heaven it be said that Mr. Harris made first practical move, when the proposition was on an absolute practical basis?

It was Mr. W. F. Cocksutt got the Government to admit that for a new public building, and was a long time before Mr. Harris became a member.
