MARKET PRICES

LOCAL MARKET.

London, Wednesday, Nov. 22. Hay was the feature of the market today. There were 45 loads offered; sales were a trifle slow, and prices as a consequence, were lower, from \$7.50 to \$8.50 being the ruling prices; mostly at \$8 per ton. Straw was sold at \$5.25 to \$6 per ton. Oats were in good demand, about 10 loads being offered. Prices were firm at \$1.02 to \$1.04 per cwt. A large load of live chickens sold at 50¢ per pound.

WEEKLY REVIEW

The markets held here during the past six days were similar to those of the previous week, so far as the supply of produce was concerned. The features of the markets were the brisk demand in nearly every line represented. Prices are generally lower than a week ago. Grain—Oats continue to be in good demand. The amount offered is sufficient to meet the demand; sales are made at \$1.02 to \$1.04 per bushel. Barley is higher at \$1.05 per bushel. Wheat is steady at 70¢ per bushel. Corn, \$1.02 to \$1.05 per cwt. Peas sell at \$1.00 per cwt.

Hay and Straw—Hay is lower in price at \$7.50 to \$8.50 per ton. Most of the sales were made at \$8 per ton. Straw is more plentiful at \$5.25 and 50¢ per ton.

Butter and Eggs—Butter is selling well at present and prices are firm at 22¢ to 23¢ for crocks and 22¢ to 23¢ for pound rolls. The English market is firm and this will help to keep the price firm on the market. Eggs sell at 22¢ to 23¢ per dozen.

Potatoes—Prices are decidedly higher at 20¢ to 25¢ per bag for the large loads and five to ten bag lots. Apples—Sales are fairly brisk at \$2 to \$3 per bushel or 75¢ to \$1.10 per cwt.

Poultry—The demand is good and the supply is increasing; sales are made at the following prices: Turkeys, dressed, 10 to 12¢ per lb; live, 10 to 12¢; geese, dressed, 7 to 8¢ per lb; ducks, dressed, 8 to 10¢ per lb; live, 8 to 10¢; chickens are the principal supply, at 7 to 8¢ per lb; live, 6 to 7¢; dressed, 5 to 6¢; old fowl sold at 5 to 6¢ per lb, and 4 to 5¢ per lb; by the pair, 50¢ to 60¢ per pair, and 5 to 6¢ per pair.

Dressed Hogs—Sales are good at \$7.50 to \$8.50 per cwt. The supply is light. Live Hogs—Monday price was \$5.50 per cwt; about the same price will be paid next Monday, small pigs sell at 45¢ to 50¢ per pair.

Butchers' Meats—Lamb sell well at 10 to 11¢ per lb; beef, 8 to 9¢ per lb; pork, 7 to 8¢ per lb; mutton is in demand at 8 to 9¢ per lb; veal, 7 to 8¢ per lb; pork, 6 to 7¢ per lb; and 5 to 6¢ per lb for hindquarters.

LIVE STOCK MARKETS.

TORONTO. Toronto, Nov. 21.—Trade was good today at the city cattle market for any kind of good stock. The supply of butchers' cattle, and for the better quality of stock and feeders. For the rough and common stuff the market is no better, and was, in fact, perhaps a little more drab than a week ago. It is only in the best class of cattle that the improvement in the cattle trade, which set in a few days ago, is fully sustained, and seems likely to continue to improve. There is a market for the rough and common, and the prices are going, but these prices are away down to as low as \$1.50. It cannot be too much insisted upon that the best prices quoted for butchers' cattle and heavy feeders are only given for the sake of the market, and generally have reference to only small lots of two or three head, and these constantly set as a sort of drag on the market. There was a fairly good run today of 84 loads of stock. The proportion of the supply of really choice cattle was small, and there were practically no export cattle offered. Good shippers are quoted at \$4.25 to \$4.50 for the right sort, the latter being for very choice heavy cattle over 1,400 lbs. Extra choice butchers' feeders sold today at \$4.50, but there were very few of these. The general run of butchers' prices were steady at last week's range. Good stockers and feeders are steady.
