LAYING OF CORNER STONE

A large concourse of citizens of Campbellton and from surrounding districts gathered at the grounds of the Soldiers Memorial Hospital last Thursday, Dominion Day, to participate in the ceremonies in connection with the laying of the corner stone of the Westbourne and Bay Chaleur Soldiers Memorial Hospital, which is now under construction.

The weather was everything which could be desired, and the event passed off without hitch.

At the procession, formed on Main street, and headed by the band, followed by a guard of honor from the members of the W. V. A., proceeded to his grave. The procession were many automobiles containing Lieut. Col. Alexander Hamilton, D.S.O., members of the Town Council, Trustees of the hospital and citizens generally.

On arrival at the grounds there was a selection by the band, after which invocation by Rev. W. Camp.

Hon. Judge McLatchy, President of the Hospital Board, acted as chairman, and before introducing the various speakers made an eloquent
