This new grape originated in Canada, and seems to be a cross between the Delaware and some purely native variety. It resembles the Delaware very much, but it ripens with the very earliest millow, even in places and seasons where sweet as soon as colored, skin tough, but thin, pulp tender, juicy, of delicious flavor, and entirely free from foxiness. Free from rot and mildew and rarely as (Thompson, and you will have a fair idea of this most valuable new variety. It never drops off its stem and when ripe gradually shrivels and dries up into raisins.
