Barley. Proprietor

The Canadian market remains unchanged from last week; holders are asking for an advance in price, which yet may be a long way off. In fact price in Toronto fell off a point, and sales of malted were made as low as 42c. 5,000 bushels sold east on Monday at 43c. In Montreal there is some activity and prices rule higher for the best grades.

Stocks in Toronto are 77,852 bush. as against 52,649 bush. at this time last year. In Montreal 48,738 as against 38,978 last year.

BUFFALO.—Stocks of barley in store have decreased 138,076 bush. during the past week, leaving quantity now here at 389,007 bush. This is about last year's supply at this date by 131,000 bush., but there is likely to be an active movement during the balance of this week. There is a decrease in stocks generally except at north-west points, where some places show increased accumulation. On the whole the movement of barley during the week is regarded as fairly satisfactory, and holders of good grades look for a firm market. The quantity of choice barley in hand for sale is very limited and millers' warehouses are by no means fully supplied. Quoted here: Western barley to fancy, 60 to 70c.; common to fairly good, 52 to 58c. Most of the common stuff is held at 53c.; choice state, 68 to 72c.

Ottawa.—Market for Canada barley unchanged. Prices entirely nominal. Stocks in store—120,000 bush. Shipments for the week—10,000 bush.

MILWAUKEE.—Quiet. Receipts 34,000 bush.; shipments 8,000 bush.; stock in store 96,505 bush.
