• Canadian carriers generally rank somewhat higher than the average of U.S. carriers in terms of unit cost. See **Table 6** and **Figure 8**. However, they have lower unit costs than the European carriers and some Asian carriers.

Financial Factors

While Canadian air carriers have high financial leverage ratios (the ratio of debt to equity capital), there are carriers, U.S. and non-U.S. alike, which have higher financial leverage, e.g. JAL.
