VIETNAM

The Secretary of State for External Affairs of Canada presents his compliments to the Parties participating in the Paris Conference on Vietnam and has the honour to inform the Parties that, with respect to Articles 12 of the Protocols concerning the International Commission for Control and Supervision, Canada will regard its nationals serving on the International Commission to be at all times "carrying out their tasks" during their service in Vietnam with the International Commission. This is without prejudice to other mutually satisfactory arrangements concerning the privileges and immunities of the personnel of national delegations which may be arrived at by the Commission and the Parties concerned.
