The Department of External Affairs announced today that the Honourable Donald Fleming, Minister of Finance, and the Honourable Gordon Churchill, Minister of Trade and Commerce, accompanied by officials from their two departments, from the Department of External Affairs, and from the Bank of Canada would visit Washington on January 6. The Canadian Ministers and officials will meet with Mr. Dillon, the Under Secretary of State, and Mr. Anderson, Secretary of the Treasury, to discuss various economic matters of common interest to both countries, including the preparations for the ministerial talks on economic matters which are to be held in Paris on January 12 and 13 as the result of the invitation extended recently on the initiative of the Governments of the United States, the United Kingdom, France and Germany.
