4. Resolved, That a sum not exceeding Sixteen thousand six hundred and sixty-six dollars and sixty-seven cents be granted to His Majesty, for Printing and distributing reports and bulletins of farms, for the year ending 31st March, 1914.

5. Resolved, That a sum not exceeding Three hundred and twelve thousand five hundred dollars be granted to His Majesty, for Exhibitions, for the year ending 31st

March, 1914.
