RESOLUTION OF U.S. SENATE RESPECTING INTERPARLIAMENTARY GROUP

86th Congress 2d Session

S. Res. 308

IN THE SENATE OF THE UNITED STATES

April 25, 1960

Resolved, That it is the sense of the Senate that the exchanges of views which took place the Canadian parliament and twenty four members of the United States congress-

1. Served to promote further the basic understandings which exist between the peoples of Canada and the United States;

2. Served to strengthen the bonds of friendship between these peoples; and

3. Served to emphasize once again the unity of purpose, the unity of thought, and the unity of spirit with which Canada and the United States seek to promote peace and freedom throughout the world.

Resolved further, That the secretary of the last week between twenty four members of Senate transmit this resolution to appropriate officers of the Canadian parliament.
