My dear Mac:-I would like if you would give me your impression as to whether or not politics have entered the Dominion Police, or whatever name is given to that body which has taken the place of the old Northwest Mounted Police. I know the politician will exert influence wherever he can but I thought that maybe the traditions of the old force were still strong enough to combat that influence.
