

A MAP OF THE FRONTIER OF British NORTH AMERICA. AND THE UNITED STATES.

DESCRIBING The Boundary line as fixed by the Treaty of 1783, which has never been respected by the American Government. LIKEWISE The New Line of Demarcation as now proposed to be established between those States and the British Provinces intended to secure the Independence of the INDIANS.

EXPLANATION.

Red. The Boundary Line as fixed by the Treaty of 1783. Blue. The Proposed Line to be now insisted on for New Brunswick and Canada; but in case that Line cannot be obtained, then the Boundary Line as coloured, Orange. Extension of Line claimed by the Americans. Boundary to the Treaty of 1763, as the Northern Boundary of the District of Maine. Territory of Ohio. Territory of Michigan. called the Western Territory assumed by the United States.
