

ALARM, *r. t.* Chines-ngulgultámshi. See Ngel.

ALAS, *Ni.*

ALIGHT, *r. t.* Chines-tipenzáti.

ALIKE, *a.* Ezagéil: All alike, 'I-ezagéil. See Agal.

ALIVE, *a.* Esgulgnilt.

ALKALI, *n.* Mgoiùlegu.

ALL, *adv.* Wholly, completely, is rendered by 'i' prefixed to the verbs or nouns. All white, 'I-pik'; All good, 'I-gest'; All wet, 'i-nas'.

All, *a.* Esià; All kinds, Es-niáksem; We must be all, we must gather together, 'Kaeks-iaam'. See Iaa.

All over, *adv.* Lesmilko, but better rendered by placing the verb between, 'Chil—ène'. Covered all over, 'Chil-ilgu-ène'; Flooded all over, 'Chil-melp-ène'. See Ielgu, Melp, and nearly all the radicals.

2d All around, Ies-chmilkomize; All over the surface, 'Es-chilmilkomène.

3d all over, inside, Es-nmilkomélze.

All together, in a pile, Esiamilsh.

ALLAY, *r. t.* Es-meelmí, Es-háu.

Allay, *r. t.* Ies-melim.

ALL-FOURS, To go on all fours, Chines-tièshi.

ALLIANCE, *n.* 1st The being allied, Siemtúégú, Nkolignéus, Stemmenúégú.

2d The compact, or treaty of alliance, Nientuéguten, Nkolig réus-ten, Ntemmennéguten.

ALLOW, See Permit.

ALLURE, *r. t.* Ies-zkukuném.

Allured, I feel allured by, Ies-zkukuném. See zuk.

ALLY, *n.* Sukoéligu.

ALMOST, *adv.* Géil nèn, Géil.

ALMS, *n.* Szguizsh (as given); Szguiz'zsh (as received); Sukonin.

2d To give alms, Chines-guizshi. See Guiz, Ies-nkornenimé.

ALOOFF, To stay aloof, Ies-nakaminem. See Uakaukat.

ALONE, *a.* I-chin-chináks, I-chilináks.

ALONG, *adv.* 1st Go along, Chines-tagolási.

2d Together with, See Together.

3d To bring along with oneself, Ies-guásem, Ies-uku'gáiem. See Bring.
