

THE FAMILY FRIEND.

TO KEEP ORANGES AND LEMONS.—Take small sand and make it very dry; after it is cold, put a quantity of it into a clean vessel; then take your oranges, and set a layer of them in the same, the stalk ends downwards, so that they do not touch each other, and strew in as much of the sand as will cover them two inches deep; then set your vessel in a cold place, and you will find your fruit in high preservation at the end of several months.

ANOTHER METHOD.—Freeze the oranges, and keep them in an ice-house. When to be used, put them into a vessel of cold water till they are thawed. By this means they may be had in perfection at any season of the year.
