

PRIVILEGED MEMBERS.

XXVII. The Committee shall have the power to admit to the privileges of the Club, as visiting members, for such periods as they may from time to time think fit, any stranger of distinguished rank or position visiting Toronto, to whom it may seem proper to offer such a compliment, but the resolution to admit them must be agreed to by a majority of the Committee.

XXVIII. Officers in Her Majesty's army and navy, and persons holding civil or military appointments under the Imperial Government who may be temporarily stationed in Canada, may be admitted to the privileges of the Club on payment of the subscription quarterly, in advance; and such strangers as may be temporarily resident in Canada, whose names have been submitted to and approved of by the Committee, shall be admitted in like manner. This privilege to strangers shall not exceed twelve months.

XXIX. All members of St. James' Club, Montreal, Stadacona Club, Quebec, The Halifax Club, Halifax, The Rideau Club, Ottawa, whose usual residence shall be one hundred miles from Toronto, shall be eligible for election on payment of an annual subscription of \$20 without entrance fee.

XXX. A member may introduce a friend, a non-resident of Ontario, for two weeks: such privilege not to be repeated within six months.

XXXI. By consent of the Committee, or a quorum thereof, non-residents of Ontario may, on
