

Article 9.

All motions (if required by the Chair) shall be made in writing and read by the mover in his or her seat before being offered.

Article 10.

The Association may elect as Honorary Members, such persons only as shall have rendered important services to the Association, or to the Country; but no person shall be elected as Honorary Member who has not at some time resided in Alberta.

Article 11.

In case of a vacancy occurring in the office of President, Vice-President, Secretary or Treasurer of the Association, the Executive Committee shall have power to fill such vacancy until the next annual meeting.

In case of the absence or illness of any officer the Executive Committee may appoint any member to fill his office for such time as they consider necessary.

Article 12.

The President on being notified of the decease of any member shall make all necessary arrangements for the representation of the Association at the funeral.

Article 13.

On a member being reported sick, or in need, the President shall appoint a visiting committee who shall have power to tender assistance, if needed, and report thereon to the Executive Committee.
