HISTORIC CHATEAU IS SEQUESTERED BY FRANCE

Blais, France, April 28—Upon the demand of the district attorney the civil court of the Department of Loire-et-Cher has sequestered the historic Chambord chateau estate on the ground that it is the property of Austrian subjects.

After the death of the Count of Chambord in 1889 the domain became the joint property of the Duke of Parma and the Duke of Bardi. It now belongs to their twenty-two coheirs, most of whom are Austrian subjects. Prince Elias of Parma is the oldest of these coheirs.
