4. Classify Hebrew parallelisms, and show the bearing which a knowledge of parallelism has upon exegesis.
5. Analyze Psalm i. Remark upon the parallelism of the first verse. What is the meaning of יָדַע in verse 6th?
6. What different views have been held of the subject of the twenty-second Psalm? Give reasons for the one you prefer. Analyze the Psalm. Account for the spirit of the closing verses.
7. Write a note on כָּאֵר, Psalm xxii. 17. What is meant by verse 27th?
8. Write a note on the reading ἐν Ἐφεσῶ in Ephesians i. 1. Give arguments furnished by the contents of the Epistle for and against the genuineness of the reading.
9. To whom does the apostle refer by ἡμεῖς in verse 12th of the first chapter, and ὑμεῖς in verse 13th? Show the connection of the verses. Sketch the history of the meaning of ἀρραβὼν (v. 14), and show its signification here. What is meant by περιποίησεως (v. 14).

4. State a few important principles bearing upon the correct exposition of the Imprecatory Psalms.
5. In Eph. ii. 8, to what does καὶ τούτο ὅντι ἐξ ὑμῶν refer?
6. Write a note on the meaning of ἐν τῷ μυστηρίῳ in Ch. iii. 4.
7. Assign reasons for not connecting the 10th verse of the third chapter with the last clause of the preceding verse.
