OUR TORONTO LETTER.

CHANGES IN PARTIES IN THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO.

The Toronto Press and its Character. Toronto, July 24.—In my last letter I called attention to the fact that Mr. John Charlton, Liberal M. P., when addressing public meetings on the subject of the Ontario Equal Rights Association, and as his meetings were usually held in connection with the formation of branch associations, I suggested that this important association would probably see the necessity of including Mr. Charlton in its ranks.

Mr. Charlton may rest assured, says the writer, "that whether rightly or wrongly there are many of thousands of our people who look on both Commercial Union and Unrestricted Reciprocity as an open door leading to the death of either scheme." The letter possesses special significance as appearing in the Mail, which has been the organ of the Commercial Unionists since the publication of its editorial in the Mail on the same day, in which it formally abandoned its advocacy of Commercial Union.

The fact cannot be overlooked that it is to our American country in all things the people of New Brunswick are to the people of the United States, than they are to those of our own Western Province. It says that although the Short Line is now in operation, and although cheap excursion trips have been provided one International steamer in one trip has brought as many passengers from New Brunswick as the whole fleet of through passengers from the Western Provinces of this Dominion.

As to the alleged sympathy and friendship of the people of the United States we have not seen much of it of late. Perhaps the Globe might explain more fully the particular of friendship which in its opinion ought to cause "to unite closer and closer in friendly bonds" with them. Was it the mobbing and unprejudiced association of the subjects of Queen Victoria, who had assembled to dine in Faneuil Hall in honor of the jubilee year? Was it the numerous displays by private persons in the United States? Or was it the recent custom regulations, which have prevented a man residing on this side of the line from earning a dollar in the United States? The interest of the Americans in us, of which the Globe speaks so feelingly, has been mainly shown in attempts to rob us of our fisheries, get the better of us in trade, exclude us from their markets, and drive us into political union with them.
